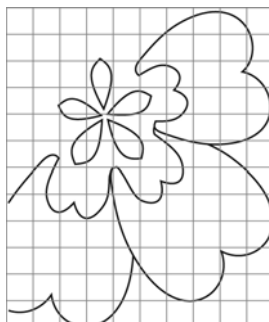
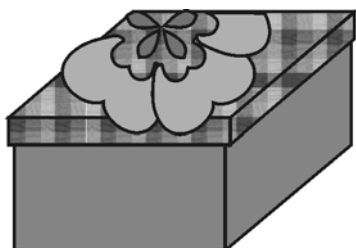


Storage box

Old box no longer classy enough? Never fear, a fabric cover will make it prettier than ever, and sturdier to boot.

Size 28 x 35 x 18 cm

Pattern: 1 Square = 2.5 x 2.5 cm



Materials

- Orange, green, brown and check linen fabric
- Cardboard box with lid, ideally with as inconspicuous and light-coloured a pattern as possible
- Bondaweb (double-sided adhesive web)
- Embroidery threads and tear-away embroidery stabiliser
- BERNINA 330, 350 or 380
- Appliqué foot no. 20 or clear foot no. 39

Cutting out

Orange fabric: 81 x 74 cm. Check fabric: 51 x 44 cm. Included in these figures are 5 cm hem on each side for the box and 4 cm on each side for the lid.

Instructions

1. Cut out and appliqué all flower sections.
2. Trim fabric again if necessary. Make sure you compare the measurements with the box you are using! Place lid in centre of fabric and mark the corners. Cut out corners as per drawing with 2.5 cm seam allowance. Snip seam allowances up to the corners. Turn under seam allowances on 2 sides and topstitch. Iron Bondaweb onto fabric and cover box.
3. Cover box in the same fashion as the lid.
