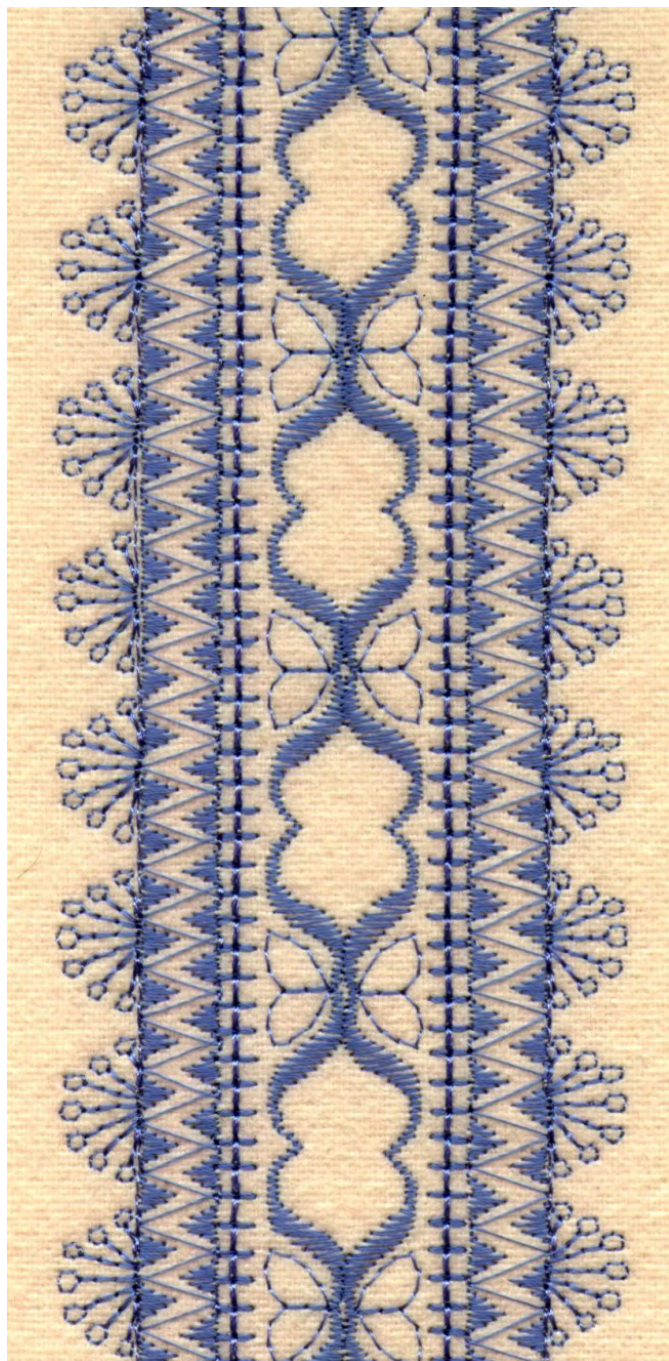

Stitching Order

REMEMBER: If your machine model does not have these exact stitches, select something similar **OR** refer to the Stitch Conversion Chart found in the Stitch Recipe Exchange area.



Combining a variety of stitches to create “one-of-a-kind” lace insertions can be very exciting with BERNINA sewing machines. There are so many different stitches to choose from, you may never want to stop creating!



Please note the **Stitching Order** as indicated under the picture.

To Begin—

- ⇒ Attach Clear Foot #34/34C
- ⇒ Begin with Stitch #450
- ⇒ Sew a row, then pivot & sew another row back. Carefully sew and line up motifs to create the center motif
- ⇒ Frame the center motif with a row of Stitch #353 on either side
- ⇒ Continue to “stack” another row of stitching on either side with Stitch #633
- ⇒ The final row of stitching added to each side is Stitch #660. Engage mirror image as necessary to complete the design combination.
- ⇒ Enjoy your embroidered insertion!
