Experience the versatility of the BERNINA 820. Experiment with the BERNINA Dual Feed, the BERNINA Stitch Regulator and the flexibility of Total Stitch Control.

Create this whimsical Clutch Purse as you experiment. It's a much fun to make as it is to carry!



Supplies

Fabric & Notions

- Get a Grip Clutch Pattern by Vicki Tracy
- 3 Fat Quarters-large floral, medium floral, tone-on-tone print
- 14" X 18" Fusible Batting (Fuse 2 Fuse)
- 1 1/2" Ribbon---5/8 yard
- 3/4" Ribbon---1 3/4 yard
- Baby Ric Rac
- Magnetic Purse Snap
- Large Button

Machine & Accessories

- BERNINA 820 Sewing Machine
- Foot #1D
- Dual Feed Edgestitch Foot #10D
- Dual Feed-Open Toe Embroidery Foot #20D
- Dual Feed-Patchwork Foot #37D
- Bernina Stitch Regulator



Cutting Instructions

- The Strip-Pieced Top
 - Large Floral: Cut 2 pieces of fabric 7" X 19"
 - Tone on Tone: Cut 1 piece of fabric 3" X 19"
- The Binding
 - Tone on Tone: Cut a 2 1/4" X 30" bias strip and a 2 1/4" X 25" bias strip. Piece if necessary.
- The Lining
 - Medium Floral: Cut 1 piece of fabric 14" X 19"

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Instructions

Strip-Piecing the Top

- Strip-piece the top pieces together using a ¼" seam allowance. Use Dual Feed Patchwork Foot # 37D to seam the 7"



pieces (large floral) to either side of the 3" center piece (tone-on-tone print). Press seams open.

Add Trims

- Attach Open Embroidery Foot #20 to the machine. Place the ric rac over seam. Using the Zig Zag Stitch #2 set



width and length to clear the ric rac. Try a width 2.7 and Length 3.7. These settings may need to be "tweaked" depending on your ric rac.

- Center the 1 ½" ribbon down the center of center fabric strip.

Attach Dual Feed Edgestitch Foot #10D. Select stitch #1 and move needle position 1-2 positions to the left side of



center. Place ribbon to the left of center guide. Stitch down both sides of ribbon. Add the ¾" ribbon to both sides of the center strip.

Embellish with Decorative Stitches



- Use the Dual Feed Open Embroidery Foot #20D for decorative stitching.

Stitch Recipe

- Center Stitch: Stitch #308, default settings. Stitch down the center of the ribbon.
- Outside Stitch: Stitch #758, default settings. Stitch on the outside edge of the ribbon with the majority of stitch off edge of ribbon.
- Stitch between Center Stitch and Edge of Ribbon: Stitch #125, width 8 & length 2.8.

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Quilt the Layers

- Layer top, fleece and lining and fuse together following the manufacturer's instructions for the fusible batting,
- Attach the Bernina Stitch Regulator and quilt the sides as desired.



- Fold and press the binding to the back. Attach Dual Feed Foot #20D. Select Stitch #766, width 8 & length 2.8, needle position far left. Stitch down binding using this decorative stitch.



Cut out the Clutch Pattern

- Cut out the clutch pattern, centering the pattern piece over the center of the quilted sandwich.

Bind the Edges

- Take each bias strip and press in half lengthwise.
- Attach Dual Feed Patchwork Foot #37. Stitch the seam binding to right side of the clutch using a ¼" seam allowance.



Finishing Touches

- Finish clutch according to pattern directions, using a magnetic snap as the closure. Embellish with button, ribbon and ric rac.
- Enjoy!
