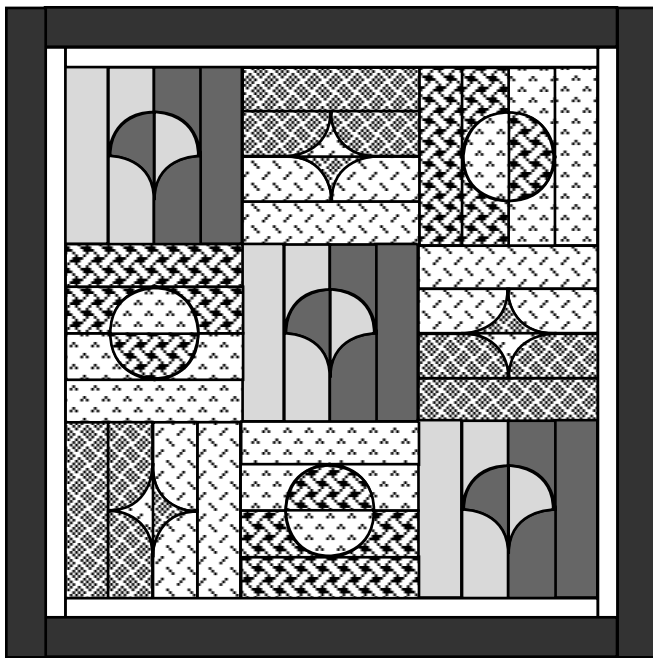


# BATIKS & MORE

36" Square minus Borders


This is a Scrap Quilt and it is made with 1 Strip of each Batik (1/8th yd), 2 Strips per Block. Each set of 2 Batiks in each Block were matched to create a set of light and dark fabrics that complemented each other. With the exception of the Blocks that are made to look like a 'Clamshell' is in the middle, the other Blocks either have a 'Star' or 'Circle' in the middle. The Blocks that have either a 'Star' or 'Circle' can be turned in any direction but the 'Clamshell' Blocks must be left facing the direction seen in the graphic above or they will look strange.


This quilt was made with the CREATIVE CURVES 3" RULER (w026R) but it can be made with any of the CREATIVE CURVES RULERS (4", 3", 2" or 1 1/2" - circular curves) - the quilt will just be either larger or smaller depending on which size Ruler is used.

The graphics in the 'pieces' that make the quilt represent any Batik Fabric that has been matched with another Batik to make 'that' type of Block. As a result, 18 fabrics were used to make the quilt, 9 light Batiks and 9 dark Batiks.

## FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

18 Strips of Batik Fabrics, coordinated into 2 sets of 9 light and 9 dark fabrics. Cut EACH of the Batiks the same sizes, then *only* re-cut the 3 small rectangles into the shapes that are seen after the small rectangles.

 - 1/4 yd Accent Fabric  
Strips: 4 - 1 1/2" X 45" for Narrow Border

 - 3/4 yd Colorful Focal Fabric  
Strips: 5 - 4 1/2" X 45" for Wide Border

## NARROW and WIDE BORDERS:





Cut 2 EACH of the following BORDER


NARROW BORDER - 1 1/2" X 36 1/2" and 1 1/2" X 38 1/2"





WIDE BORDER - 4 1/2" X 38 1/2" and 4 1/2" X 46 1/2"


Step 1. Cut the indicated number of the following pieces from EACH of the Strips. You will be making 3 'Clamshell' Blocks, 3 'Star' Blocks and 3 'Circle' Blocks.

Step 2. Sew the following pieces in the sequence seen below. Make 3 sets.

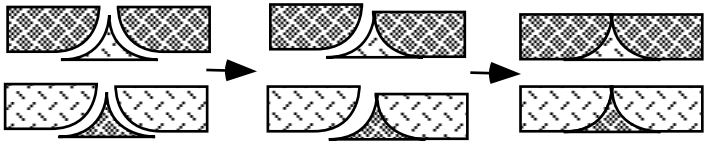


Step 3. Sew the following pieces in the sequence seen below. Make 3 sets of Blocks.

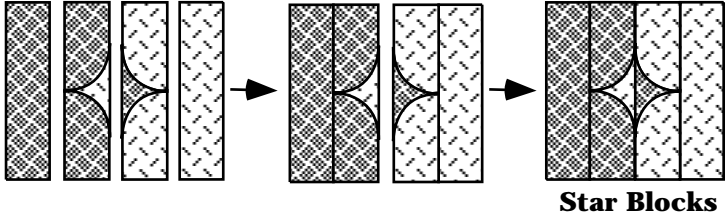


Clamshell Blocks

Step 4. Sew the following pieces in the sequence seen below. Make 3 sets.

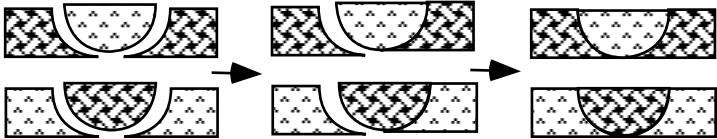


Step 5. Sew the following pieces in the sequence seen below. Make 3 sets of Blocks.

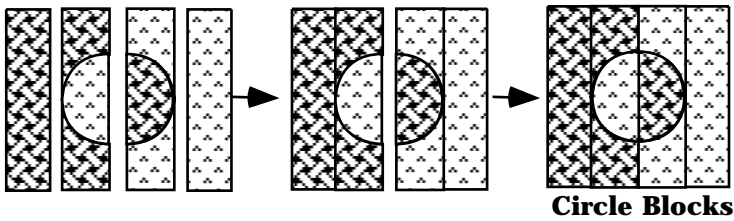


**Star Blocks**

Step 6. Sew the following pieces in the sequence seen below. Make 3 sets.

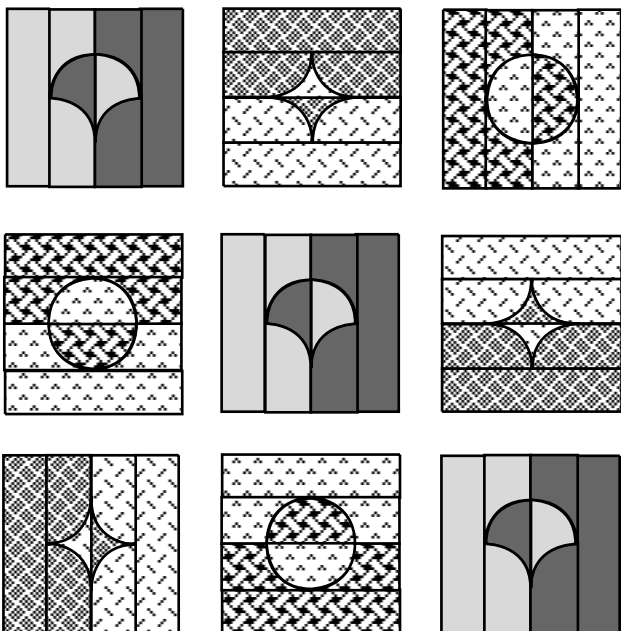


Step 7. Sew the following pieces in the sequence seen below. Make 3 sets of Blocks.

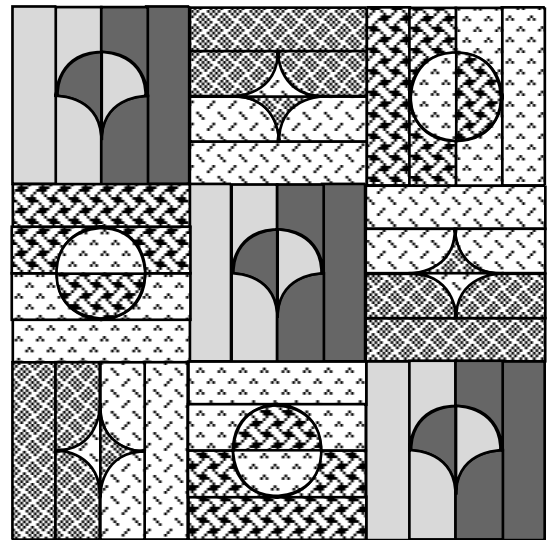
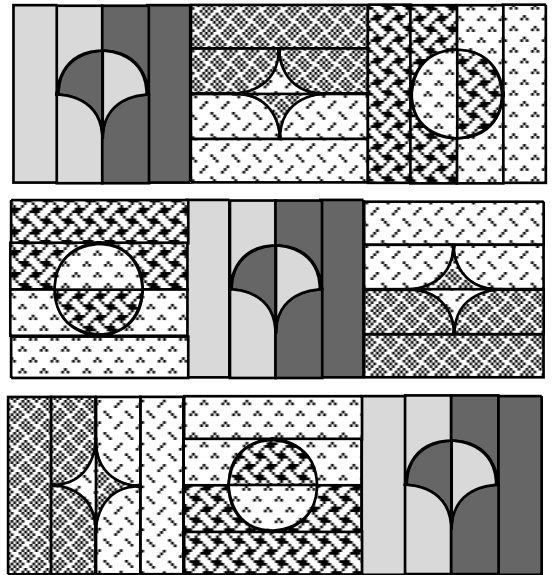


**Circle Blocks**

Step 8. Align the Blocks from Steps 3, 5, and 7 in the sequence seen below. Then sew together in Rows.



Step 9. Sew the Rows together.



Step 10. Sew the Narrow Borders to the body of the quilt first, sewing the closest opposite sides and then the remaining opposite sides. Then sew the Wide Border in the same sequence.
